



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How it works







- Aged 18+
- Unemployed and ready for work
- Speak good conversational English (level 1)
- Have access to an email address and a phone
- Keen to make progress with their job search to move into work, volunteering or education
- Comfortable with having conversations with their coach either by phone or online
- Able to commit to 6 coaching sessions (60-90 minutes) across 10-12 weeks



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Who the programme can support

I have no work history. I'm a refugee who is currently at college. I need help with mock interviews and interview techniques. I've attended interviews in the past, frozen and stuttered.

l haven't worked for 10 years. Returning to work after having a child, I have worked in a betting office and supermarket, I'm now looking to have a career.

I have difficulties with digital skills, particularly emails and online applications.

I spent 20 years in publishing and journalism as a picture editor and researcher. I have a brand strategy and marketing background (marketing director) and client service director. I was made redundant in March having been employed for 10 years as an events coordinator.

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
Opportunity
